- Adventure Travel Insurance Policy – Cow Elk License – Driver's License Cash – Credit Cards – Travel Gun Case Keys
- Airline Tickets and Vehicle Rental Confirmations – Car Registration and New Tabs – Meat Trailer – Extra Car Key
- Prescription Medicines – (20) Ibuprofen – Lubricated Eye Drops for "dry eye" – Diabetic Supplies – Cold Soar Medicativo
- Clear Safety Glasses for Riding Horses – Extra Eye Glasses – Extra Contacts – Chap Stick – Sunscreen –
- Excellent quality high dollar binoculars – Bino Lens Cover – Thick Coat Hangers for your cabin Hearing Aid Batteries
- (2) Small Flashlights – Extra Flashlight Batteries – AAA and AA batteries or 123 – CPAP Machine, CPAP 15' Ext Cord
- Scope set in steel mounts not aluminum – exception is Night force Lightweight Aluminum Rings – AAA Auto Info
- Removable Scope Covers – Rifle Sling – Your favorite Sleeping Pillow – Spotting Scope is not required
- Shooting sticks – Bipods do not fit in our scabbards – 56mm scopes do not fit in our scabbards – Benadryl for insect bite
- (2) Hankies for lens wiping – Lens cleaning solution to leave in your cabin and use every night on binos and scopes
- (1) Extra rifle and ammo for your group in case of a malfunction – bring one everyone will be comfortable shooting.
- Beer – Wine – alcohol to your liking and mixers. Bring ice if you like ice in your cocktails, ice is only available in town of Augusta.
- Extra Warm Hunting Pack Boots that fit snug and are good for hiking. Brands we like are Arctic Pro or Arctic Sport by Muck.
- Easy on off light weight warm footwear to wear at the guest ranch and your cabin
- Quality Winter Hunting Coat – with wind stopper made of quiet waterproof material – very small folding lightweight mirror
- Insulated pants – with wind stopper made of quiet water proof material
- Long Soft Thin Neck Scharf – keeps wind off your neck
- Warm Winter Hat with earflaps that can be either down or up depending on what the weather is doing at the moment.
- Two pairs of warm gloves or mittens that are quiet and waterproof.
- Note – If you take a 16-penny nail and scrape it on any of your outer garments and it makes a noise you might not want to bring then. Big game animals have a keen sense of hearing and noise,
- Noisy outer clothing can spook your target and rune your hunt.
- Charcoal Hand Warmers (12) per hunter
- Small Insulated Sitting Pad – we may be sitting in snow at times.
- 2 Wool or Fleece Long Sleeve Shirts – Underwear – tops and bottoms – Socks
- Electric Boot Dryer, nice option if your feet sweat.
- Compass or GPS – with Montana Private and National Forest Maps installed when or if you hunt on your own.
- Hunting knife, we like the Outdoor Edge Razor Knife with extra blades – we like to travel light!
- Cell Phone and charger – camera or GoPro
- 100' outdoor Extension Cord – Snow Broom – Fuel Conditioner – (2) Tire Chains and tighter, the weather can change fast in Montana
- Bore Snake and gun cleaning kit for you rifle
- Electrical Tape
- Each hunter should bring a few of these Large yard Bags; Gallon, Quart, Sandwich, Snack Zip Locks, Para Cord
- Personal Bath Towels and wash cloth
- There is no laundry for hunting guests at Ford Creek Guest Ranch, so bring plenty of fresh clothes for your stay.
